



International Tuition Fees 2010 Postgraduate Articulations and Two-Year Two-Course Combinations

Tuition fees are dependent on the actual year of commencement and are subject to change without notice and annual increases.

Articulations

An Articulation is a formal arrangement which allows you to successfully complete a specified one-year course, and effectively gain credit toward a second course, in order to complete the second course in a shorter period than normally required

In all of the Articulations described below, the second course would normally require 1.5 - 2 years to complete; however because it is approved as a formal articulation, you can complete the second course with one more year of full-time study, thereby saving on the full cost of the second course.

An offer of admission can be given to both courses upon application, allowing you to obtain a visa for the full two-years to complete both Masters; or you can apply for articulation into the second course after completing the first course listed in the combinations below.

Articulations into the Master Of Business Administration

The following programs articulate into the MBA.

In addition to meeting the entry requirement for the first Masters, applicants should have at least one year of full-time relevant professional experience in order to progress to the MBA.
